

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING  
MINUTES  
February 20, 2018**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:31p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Henry, Schneider, Bennett, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider and Secretary Adkins. Commissioner Bradley was absent. Jack Heath and his wife, Linda was also present.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to approve the minutes from the February 5<sup>th</sup> regular meeting. A second was made by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

President Gosnell stated Delmarva Power is scheduled to install the new service at the water plant for the solar project the week of March 12<sup>th</sup>. Comcast is in the process of installing internet service at the water plant.

President Gosnell stated construction has started on the Dollar General.

Commissioner Bennett stated the building being used for the Historical Museum is in serious need of repair, and there are leaks that they worry will damage the historical items being kept there. The Commissioners discussed alternative places to store the items until the building is repaired and Commissioner Bennett stated he would contact Circuit Rider Joe Mangini about looking for grant opportunities for the building.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

President Gosnell introduced a guest in attendance. Salisbury City Council President and member of the MML Board of Directors, Jack Heath spoke to the Commissioners about a hearing at the State Capitol on a Highway User Revenue bill, which is sponsored by Delegate Carl Anderton, which would restore the amounts of HUR back to the amounts municipalities received before they were cut. Mr. Heath also is a candidate for Wicomico County Executive and spoke about how would like to see the County change.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioners comments. There were none.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to adjourn, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell adjourned the meeting at 8:14pm
