

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
April 15, 2019**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Bennett, Bradley, Schneider, and Henry, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, Secretary Adkins, and residents Jean Cordrey and Nancy Springer.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to approve the minutes from the April 1st regular meeting. A second was made by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Bradley made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5, which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

President Gosnell stated the Chevrolet S-10 pickup was listed for sale on Craigslist and there were four offers received, \$2100, \$2000, \$1700, \$1525. Commissioner Bradley made a motion to accept the highest bid of \$2100.00, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell stated the paving on School Street has been completed.

President Gosnell reported that the foreclosure process has started on 502 Nanticoke Street and should take approximately 60 days to complete.

President Gosnell stated he and Circuit Rider Joe Mangini have scheduled meetings with marine contractors to get estimates for replacing the bulkhead with riprap up to the old bridge. Mr. Mangini will be applying for a grant through the Department of Natural Resources.

President Gosnell stated the Commissioners held a work session on April 4th to discuss a retirement plan for Town employees. The Commissioners feel an IRA plan is the best option. Commissioner Bennett made a motion for the Town to provide an IRA retirement plan for the Town employees, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. Commissioner Schneider abstained from voting, the remaining Commissioners voted aye, so carried.

President Gosnell reminded the Commissioners to RSVP if planning to attend the ESAM meeting.

President Gosnell stated there was nothing to update on Pecan Corner but the Town has been informed that building permits for new construction, additions, and accessory structures all need to be submitted to the County for storm water review.

NEW BUSINESS:

There was no new business to discuss.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioners comments. There were none.

President Gosnell asked for public comments. There were none.

Commissioners Bradley made a motion to adjourn the Commissioners meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell adjourned the meeting at 7:50pm.
