

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING
MINUTES
July 19, 2021**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Bennett, Bradley, Henry, and Schneider, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, Secretary Adkins, Jean Cordrey and Nancy Springer.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to approve the minutes from the July 5th regular meeting, which seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Bennett made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5 which was seconded by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor, so carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

The Commissioners read an update from Superintendent White on the sewer plant project.

President Gosnell stated he and Joe Mangini met with Bhaskar from DNR and Mary Phipps from MDE to discuss permitting for the bulkhead project.

President Gosnell stated Clerk/Treasurer Schneider has submitted the required documents to Hebron Savings Bank for the line of credit. The Town has not yet received the Recovery Act funds.

President Gosnell stated the County provided the Town with signs to be placed at Cherry Beach to deter jumping from the pier and swimming in the boat launch area.

NEW BUSINESS:

The Commissioners received a request from the Historical Commission to approve Judy Walker Ennis as a new member of the Historical Commission. Commissioner Bradley made a motion to approve Judy Walker Ennis as a new member of the Historical Commission, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

The Commissioners received a request from the Parks and Recreation Commission to donate money towards the fireworks display on Heritage Day. After discussion, Commissioner Schneider made a motion to donate \$1000 from the Rainy Day fund to the Parks and Recreation Commission for the fireworks display, which was seconded by Commissioner Henry. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioners comments. Commissioner Schneider stated the Parks and Recreation would not be participating in the County's soccer program, instead will be joining with Mardela Springs for the season.

Commissioner Bennett stated planning for Heritage Day is ongoing.

President Gosnell asked for public comment. Nancy Springer commented on a profane political sign in Town.

Commissioner Bradley made a motion to adjourn the Commissioners meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. All were in favor, so carried.

President Gosnell adjourned the meeting at 7:54p.m.
