

**SHARPTOWN REGULAR MEETING  
MINUTES  
August 5, 2019**

President Gosnell called the meeting to order at 7:30p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Bennett, Bradley, Schneider, and Henry, Clerk/Treasurer Schneider, and Secretary Adkins. Residents Jean Cordrey, Roland Quenneville and Circuit Rider Joe Mangini were also present.

Commissioner Bennett a motion to approve the minutes from the July 15<sup>th</sup> regular meeting. A second was made by Commissioner Bradley. All were in favor, so carried.

Commissioner Bradley made a motion to pay the bills as stated on pages 4 and 5, which was seconded by Commissioner Schneider. All were in favor, so carried.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

President Gosnell stated the hydrants were flushed and there were no issues.

President Gosnell stated there have been issues with high BOD and TSS test results at the sewer plant. They are doing additional testing to identify the cause of the issues.

President Gosnell stated on August 7<sup>th</sup> he, Superintendent White, and engineers from DBF will be meeting to discuss the maintenance on the water tower and the aeration system.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Clerk/Treasurer Schneider reported there was a bat inside the Town Hall building. Superintendent White was able to catch it and release it outside. She asked the Commissioners for permission to call an exterminator to make sure there aren't any more up in the ceiling. The Commissioners agreed to call an exterminator.

President Gosnell asked for Commissioners comments. Commissioner Schneider stated soccer has started and there are 92 children signed up to play.

Commissioner Bennett stated the theme for Heritage Day will be "Red White and Blue" and they will display military memorabilia.

President Gosnell asked for public comments.

Commissioner Schneider made a motion to adjourn the Commissioners meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Bennett were in favor, so carried.
